



Brazil: Rio de Janeiro/Fortaleza/Rio Sat. March 8th - Sun. March 16th

This mission is designed to bring medical/dental care to the villages near Fortaleza. At the end of the mission the team will have a weekend to explore and experience Rio de Janeiro. Working with local medical authorities and FUNDAMED, a non-profit foundation founded in 1997, our focus will be general medical & dental care for those living in abject poverty. Three days of medical/dental clinic are planned (Mon. - Wed.). Surgeons are welcome (though on this mission as a GP) as surgery is possible here in future missions.

During the clinic days the team will stay at a very nice hostel and work nearby at a local clinic. In addition to the medical/dental clinic there will be a day to explore Fortaleza and a weekend in Rio.

Free day in Praia do Presidio, a fishing village. The beautiful white sandy beach with clear water are the things commonly associated with Fortaleza on Brazil's Northeast tip. There will be a welcome dinner for the team at 7:00 PM.
