MISSION ITINERARY:

April 25 (Saturday night) Fly USA to Lima

Many flights from the USA will arrive between 10 pm and midnight. You may not have enough time to go to a hotel. You can wait in the airport until check-in for your flight. The Lima airport is quite nice and the restaurants and shops are open all night.

April 26 (Sunday) Lima to Cusco

The team will assemble in the Lima airport for a morning flight to Cusco. Your trip leader will meet you in Cusco outside of baggage claim in front of the airport. We will travel by bus and or train to the Sacred Valley. Exact locations of hotels and mission sites will be available in late July. However, we expect at least one mission day in the village of Machu Picchu and 2 days in smaller towns in the Sacred Valley.

April 30 (Thursday) Visit Ruins in Machu Picchu, Return to Cusco

The day will be free for visiting the ruins. I suggest you go early in the morning to beat the crowds, as Machu Picchu is most spectacular before it fills with people arriving on the tourist trains. You must buy your admission ticket to the ruins in town before you take the bus up to the ruins. In the early afternoon, we will take the train and a bus back to Cusco, where we will stay in a hotel for 2 nights.

May 1 (Friday) Explore the ancient city of Cusco

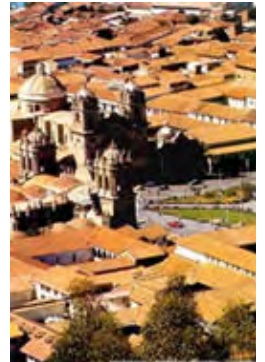
Cusco is one of my favorite towns. You should try to visit the Coricancha, Sacsaywaman, and the Cathedral. A morning city tour will be arranged for those in the group who wish to go (at your cost). It is the most efficient way to see everything. Save time in the afternoon for shopping in the Artisan Market or in shops around the



Plaza de Armas.

May 2 (Saturday) Fly to Lima, and then back to the USA

Flights from Cusco to Lima will depart around noon unless you request otherwise well in advance. You will have time in Lima to shop or take a tour on your own. Most flights to the USA leave around midnight, so be careful to book the correct departure date (e.g. Your flight could be at 11:30 on Saturday October 6 or at 1 am on Sunday October 7th).
