



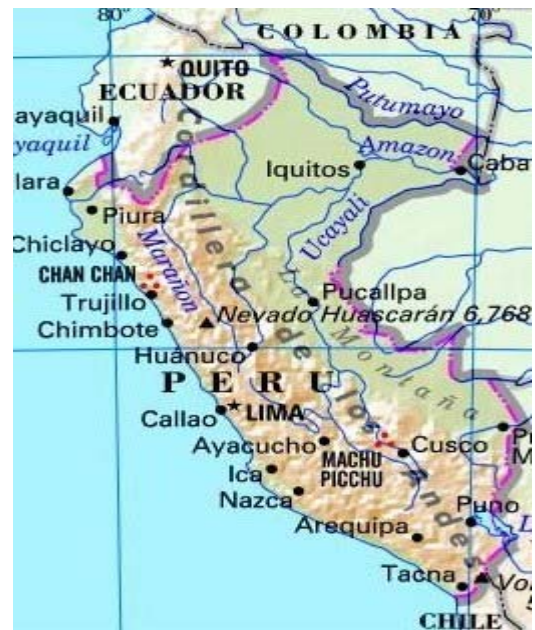
Cusco/Machu Picchu, Peru 2011

June 11th (Saturday) – June 18th (Saturday)

This mission is designed to bring medical/dental care to remote communities near Cusco, Peru. Physicians, dentists and support personnel needed. We will be focusing on communities that are off the tourist trail. Our home base will be the quiet, unimposing town of Huarrocondo. This town of 3000+ has unique Inca ruins, a beautiful church and is about 1 hour by bus from Cuzco. From Huarrocondo we will go out to other communities.

We have set up this mission so that you will arrive early in the morning Sunday in Cuzco and have a chance to see a bit of the world renowned Plaza de Armas. After a quick breakfast and before altitude sickness you will head out to the communities.

You will stay Sunday- Tuesday nights in Huarrocondo, working in clinics Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. At the end of your clinic day, Wednesday, you will go back to Cuzco, where the altitude should no longer affect you. You will stay at a very nice 3star hotel near the plaza. You will visit Machu Picchu on Thursday. Friday is a free day to explore Cuzco. **June 11th** Saturday Depart USA.



Flights from the US usually arrive late at night. Depending on your arrival time, you may have time to stay in a hotel overnight. However, if your flight arrives at 4 am Sunday morning (as some do), you may consider staying in the airport, which is clean and safe.

June 12th Sunday -- Arrive in Lima / Cusco

You should arrive at the LIMA airport at least 2 hours before your flight to Cusco (6am). Normally our flights depart Lima for Cusco at 8am. It is a short flight.

In Cusco you will be met at the airport by your area coordinator who will help with luggage and whisk you off to see the plaza, get a cup of coffee or mate de coca (best for altitude) and then head out for the town of the town Huarcocondo. In Huarcocondo you will settle in and have time to explore the local ruins and church.

June 13th Monday -- Medical/Dental Clinic: Angascocha 10,900'

June 14th Tuesday -- Medical/Dental Clinic: Pucyura 10,900'

June 15th Wednesday -- Medical/Dental Clinic: Huarcocondo 10,900'

At the end of our clinic day we will return to Cusco 11,000' where we will stay at a wonderful 3 star hotel. After dinner you are free to try out the nightlife.

June 16th Thursday – Machu Picchu

Train leaves 6:15am! Return to Cusco 8pm
(Lunch NOT Provided)

June 17th Friday - Cusco Day

Morning walking tour of the colonial city is planned and little known places will be explored. Then you have the rest of the day to shop and explore. Our adios amigos dinner is at 7:30pm ... this is where you can say goodbye to your translators, fellow Peruvian coworkers and each other.



June 18th Saturday - Return to USA

We will fly to Lima and have time for shopping and dinner before you catch your “red eye” flight home. *** Heads-up: The week following this mission is the famed Inti Raymi, a religious ceremony of the Inca Empire in honor of the god Sun, marking the winter solstice (think Mardi Gras in the Andes) http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Inti_Raymi

It is highly recommended that you stay for a few days and enjoy the festival. We can help you get inexpensive but good accommodations if you let us know in advance (a few months in advance). This is not part of the mission but worth the stay over.
