



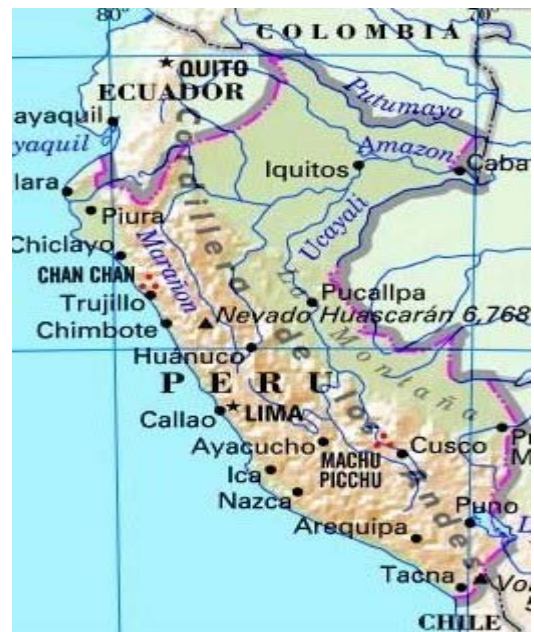
Cusco/Machu Picchu, Peru 2010

CW 2' fX (Sat) – October ' \$H fGUŁ

This mission is designed to bring medical/dental care to remote communities near Cusco, Peru. Physicians, dentists and support personnel needed. We will be focusing on communities that are off the tourist trail. Our 'home base' will be the quite, unimposing town of Limatambo. This town of 3000+ has unique Inca ruins and is about 3 hours from Cuzco. From Limatambo we will go out to other communities.

We have set up this mission so that you will arrive early in the morning in Cuzco and have a chance to see a bit of the world renowned Plaza de Armas. After a quick breakfast, and before attitude sickness makes your life miserable we will drive down to Limatambo (8700' or 2650meters).

You will stay Sunday- Tuesday nights in Limatambo, working in clinics Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. At the end of your clinic day, Wednesday, you will go back to Cuzco, where the altitude should no longer affect you. You will stay at a very nice 3star hotel near the plaza. You will visit Machu Picchu on Thursday. Friday is a free day to explore Cuzco.



October 25th Saturday – Depart USA

Flights from the US usually arrive late at night. Depending on your arrival time, you may have time to stay in a hotel overnight. However, if your flight arrives at 4 am Sunday morning (as some do), you may consider staying in the airport, which is clean and safe.

October 24th Sunday -- Arrive in Lima / Cusco

You should arrive at the LIMA airport at least 2 hours before your flight to Cusco. It is a short flight.

In Cusco you will be met at the airport by your area coordinator who will help with luggage and whisk you off to see the plaza, get a cup of coffee or mate de coca (best for altitude) and then head out for the town of the town Limatambo. Altitude can affect you - so, we have chosen to acclimate down in the valley of Limatambo (8700' or 2650meters) by the time you return to Cusco you will be acclimated. In Limatambo you will settle in and have time to explore the local ruins.

October 25th Monday -- Medical/Dental Clinic

October 26th Tuesday -- Medical/Dental Clinic

October 27th Wednesday -- Medical/Dental Clinic

At the end of our clinic day we will return to Cusco 11,000' where we will stay at a wonderful 3 star hotel. After dinner you are free to try out the nightlife.

October 28th Thursday – Machu Picchu

Train leaves 6:15am! Return to Cusco 8pm
(Lunch NOT Provided)

October 29th Friday - Cusco Day

Morning walking tour of the colonial city is planned and little known places will be explored. Then you have the rest of the day to shop and explore. Our 'adios amigos' dinner is at 7:30pm ... this is where you can say goodbye to your translators, fellow Peruvian coworkers and each others.



October 30th Saturday - Return to USA

Morning Flights for Lima 11am and then your connections for your return to USA
